

WHAT DID THE TEAM OF LEGA PRO ANIMALE DO IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF THE YEAR 2012

“SPAY DAYS”



Around 150 cats are spayed/neutered in only one day thanks to numerous volunteers. In the first 6 months of 2012 417 cats were done (281 female and 136 male).

ROCCA D'EVANDRO:



The entire village (3000 inhabitants) was controlled by LPA-vets together with the town police. 686 owned dogs were identified with a microchip and registered. Most of the private dogs are allowed to roam freely, therefore we searched for a sponsor to neuter them. Thanks to the **Humane Society International** that took over the expenses for surgery we were able to spay/neuter 64 dogs and 50 cats. Most of them went through surgery in an icy room the town council had at our disposal. The animals were kept in between warm blankets in a heated corner until the owners picked them up. ADOZIONE STRADA



Anyone who finds a dog in the street and is willing to keep it and register it in his name can receive from LEGA PRO ANIMALE free spaying/neutering and free microchipping. Until the end of June and thanks to the Gazan Foundation in Switzerland already 282 dogs have been “re-homed” in the area without causing expenses for the stay in a shelter and/or transportation.

“MINI SPAY DAYS”

The demand is enormous and we try very hard to spay/neuter as many cats as we can. Nearly every Wednesday morning up to 60 animals are going through surgery. We started to do so because so many caretakers asked us for free spaying/neutering of stray cats. Besides the “SPAY DAYS” we already operated on 725 cats (508 female and 217 tom cats).



Is an Italian non profit association (registered with number 008/A in the register of the animal protection organisations at the the Region of Campania). Its **MISSION STATEMENT** is that each dog and cat needs a caring owner (no more dogs and cats living permanently in the streets and in overcrowded shelters).
